Doncaster Champion of the Year

Stage 2 Judging Date: **Wednesday 16th September 2026, 09:00-18:00 at Eco-Power Stadium**

Eligibility

- This award is open to individuals who have made a significant and sustained contribution to championing Doncaster as a place to live, work, visit, or invest in.
- Only businesses in DN postcode OR Doncaster Chamber members can apply.

Criteria

- Contributions can take a variety of forms, including (but not limited to): place promotion, community leadership, partnership working, inward investment support, or initiatives that improve the perception and experience of Doncaster.
- The nominee should have demonstrated consistent commitment to promoting and enhancing Doncaster over a sustained period, not solely through a one-off initiative.
- The nominee must have shown sustained commitment and impact, through initiatives, leadership, or advocacy, over the past 12 months.
- All completed entry forms must be submitted by Sunday 7th June 2026
- Stage 2 judging will take place on Wednesday 16th September 2026 at Eco-Power Stadium between 09:00-18:00. Please ensure to block this out in your diary should you progress to this stage. This cannot be moved.
- Maximum of 3 categories per company can be entered.
- Word count must be adhered to avoid disqualification

Questions & Guidance

You will be scored against these questions (Max 400 words per question)

1. Describe how the nominee actively champions Doncaster as a place to live, work, visit, or invest in. How have they promoted the borough locally, regionally, or nationally? Provide specific examples of their advocacy and influence.
2. Explain how the nominee has contributed to improving Doncaster's places and communities. What tangible difference have they made? Include examples of initiatives, projects, or actions that have enhanced the local area.
3. Demonstrate how the nominee brings people, businesses, or organisations together to benefit Doncaster. How have they shown leadership or acted as a catalyst for positive change? Provide examples of partnerships or collaborations they have led or supported.
4. Outline the nominee's ongoing commitment to Doncaster. How have they consistently demonstrated passion, dedication, and long-term support for the borough? Include evidence of sustained effort rather than one-off activity.
5. What has been the overall impact of the nominee's efforts on Doncaster? Provide evidence such as outcomes, successes, recognition, or lasting legacy. How has their contribution helped shape a stronger, more positive future for the borough?
