Partnership of the Year

Stage 2 Judging Date: **Wednesday 16th September 2026, 09:00-18:00 at Eco-Power Stadium**

Eligibility

- The award is open to all businesses but must be jointly entered by two or more businesses working together.
- Only businesses in DN postcode OR Doncaster Chamber members can apply.

Criteria

- Financials must be completed for your entry to be put forward for stage 1 judging. Should there be any discrepancies in your financials please ensure to explain in your answer.
- Entries must have a Doncaster focus specifically referencing impact your business has had on the area or community.
- Eligible organisations should be reflecting on the past 12 months activity prior to entry
- All completed entry forms must be submitted by Sunday 7th June 2026
- Stage 2 judging will take place on Wednesday 16th September 2026 at Eco-Power Stadium between 09:00-18:00. Please ensure to block this out in your diary should you progress to this stage. This cannot be moved.
- Maximum of 3 categories per company can be entered.
- Word count must be adhered to avoid disqualification

Questions & Guidance

You will be scored against these questions (Max 400 words per question).

1. Explain the vision and performance of the business/organisation, including financial performance
2. Describe your partnership and what you were you trying to achieve through it.
3. Describe your strategic aims (in a way that is measurable), any pertinent activities that you have undertaken, and ultimately how the collaboration works in practice. Detail how you have you worked with the partner in question to open up new opportunities for both organisations.
4. Describe how and why your partnership came about, what make it unique. Make sure to be thorough and to tell a coherent story. Explain what makes your partnership stand out from normal customer relations.
5. Provide evidence on how the partnership has contributed to both businesses success and growth. Supply concrete evidence that shows how your partnership has been a success. Include any stats that show growth; relevant metrics; case studies etc. Demonstrate the effect that your partnership has had on your (and your partner's) financial performance.
6. Describe any opportunities that you have been able to seize with the partnership that would otherwise have been inaccessible. For instance, perhaps you've accessed new markets, or improved your products and services in a major way. Emphasise how this relationship and collaborative working has benefited your partner organisation as well as yourself.
